



CNA RECERTIFICATION

AT METHODIST COLLEGE

CNA Recertification is for individuals who have previously practiced as a CNA in the state of Illinois, but have not provided nursing or nursing related services for pay in 24 consecutive months, which results in the loss of certification. To become recertified, individuals must complete three steps:

1. Contact the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) to determine eligibility for recertification. If eligible, IDPH will send a recertification information packet. IDPH can be reached (217) 785-5133 or visit the website at: www.dph.illinois.gov.
2. Pass the Manual Skills Performance test with an approved evaluator.
3. Sit for the State Exam.

Methodist College is an approved evaluator for the Manual Skills Performance Test. The cost for this test is \$225. For more information or to register for an upcoming skills test visit:
