
Café/Store Manager

Responsibilities:

- 1. Promotes MC and the Café/Campus Store in a positive and professional manner at all times.
- 2. Accurately and efficiently rings up items and accept payment for purchases.
- 3. Balance drawer and prepare daily cash reports.
- 4. Ensure that appropriate levels of petty cash are available for Café/Campus Store.
- 5. Assist with questions as needed.
- 6. Maintain an awareness of all promotions and advertisements.
- 7. Communicate customers' needs and request to Café/Store Manager.
- 8. Maintain orderly appearance of Café/Campus Store at all times.
- 9. Ensure that each customer receives outstanding service by providing a friendly environment.
- 10. Stock Café/Campus Store with merchandise and food items.
- 11. Make coffee and other related drinks as needed.
- 12. Keep track of inventory. Let Café/Store Manager know when supplies are low.
- 13. Purchase inventory when requested.
- 14. Prepare food stocks for the day.
- 15. Back-up Campus Store/Cafe as needed

Physical and Mental Requirements:

- Ability to stand for extended periods of time
- Ability to perform repetitive tasks
- Ability to move/lift objects weighing up to 30 lbs
- Ability to carry objects weighing up to 25 lbs
- Ability to grip/grasp, stoop, crouch and kneel
- Ability to work independently and analytically
- Ability to deal with degrees of stress and cope with confrontation
- Ability to concentrate
- Ability to speak in normal tone



- Ability to hear at normal level
- Visual acuity at normal range with or without correction

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL EFFORT:

- Work is normally performed in a typical interior-office work environment.
- No or very limited exposure to physical risk.
- Noise levels not above a point that hearing protection is needed.

COMMUNICATION:

- Excellent communication skills.
- Interacts effectively with students, staff, faculty, and external clients of MC.
- Must have ability to interact effectively and courteously with culturally diverse groups.
- Ability to communicate only the facts to recipients or to decline to reveal information.
- Ability to project a professional, friendly, and helpful demeanor.
