Temporary injuries and pregnancy:

Temporary injuries are not covered by the ADA unless the condition lasts more than 6 months. However, Methodist College will provide reasonable accommodations in certain cases. Accommodations are approved on a case by case basis for conditions such as broken bones, concussions, pregnancy, etc. Accommodations will not typically be approved for temporary illnesses.

- Student notifies Director of Simulation and Clinical Affairs that they are temporarily injured or pregnant and is requesting temporary accommodations
- Director of Simulation and Clinical Affairs meets with student and completes a Request for Accommodations: Temporary Injury form.
- Director of Simulation and Clinical Affairs will meet with the student to discuss approved accommodations and timeframe.
