Assistant Professor of Nursing – Adjunct Position Description

Education:

Faculty must have a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN). Must also have a terminal degree (PhD, DNP) in nursing or related field.

Experience:

Faculty shall have had a minimum of five years of nursing education experience or practice experience specific to the terminal degree.

Licensure:

Faculty member shall hold a current unrestricted license as a registered nurse in Illinois. Active CPR required for teaching nurses courses.

Reports to:

Associate Provost, Dean of Nursing and Health Professions or designee.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide clinical and/or didactic educational instruction to students.
- 2. Engage as a scholar and expert to enhance and precipitate course and program improvements using the appropriate professional venues as appropriate in an adjunct role.
- 3. Serve as a student advocate and provide guidance as needed regarding student performance and course/program outcomes.
- 4. Serve as a Methodist College advocate to students and community/college constituents.
- 5. Provide service to the community through application of professional expertise.
- 6. Assist in recruiting qualified students to the program.
- 7. Other duties as assigned.

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL EFFORT:

- Work is normally performed in a typical interior-office work environment.
- No or very limited exposure to physical risk.
- No or very limited physical effort required.
- Noise levels not above a point that hearing protection is needed.

COMMUNICATION:

- Excellent communication skills.
- Interacts effectively with students, staff, faculty, and external clients of MC.
- Must have ability to interact effectively and courteously with culturally diverse groups.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality where appropriate.
- Ability to project a professional, friendly, and helpful demeanor.
