

Assistant Professor of Nursing – Adjunct
Position Description

Education:

Faculty must have a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN). Must also have a terminal degree (PhD, DNP) in nursing or related field.

Experience:

Faculty shall have had a minimum of five years of nursing education experience or practice experience specific to the terminal degree.

Licensure:

Faculty member shall hold a current unrestricted license as a registered nurse in Illinois. Active CPR required for teaching nurses courses.

Reports to:

Associate Provost, Dean of Nursing and Health Professions or designee.

Responsibilities:

1. Provide clinical and/or didactic educational instruction to students.
2. Engage as a scholar and expert to enhance and precipitate course and program improvements using the appropriate professional venues as appropriate in an adjunct role.
3. Serve as a student advocate and provide guidance as needed regarding student performance and course/program outcomes.
4. Serve as a Methodist College advocate to students and community/college constituents.
5. Provide service to the community through application of professional expertise.
6. Assist in recruiting qualified students to the program.
7. Other duties as assigned.

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL EFFORT:

- Work is normally performed in a typical interior-office work environment.
- No or very limited exposure to physical risk.
- No or very limited physical effort required.
- Noise levels not above a point that hearing protection is needed.

COMMUNICATION:

- Excellent communication skills.
- Interacts effectively with students, staff, faculty, and external clients of MC.
- Must have ability to interact effectively and courteously with culturally diverse groups.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality where appropriate.
- Ability to project a professional, friendly, and helpful demeanor.
