

Nursing Assistant Tuition Payment Schedule and Reimbursement Schedule

Tuition, Fees and Miscellaneous Costs

Tuition for the Nursing Assistant program is \$1,500.

Fees billable through your student account for the program total \$130 and include:

\$50 Fingerprinting-Background Check Fee (*paid at Orientation, which is held the Thursday before the start of classes*)

\$50 Technology Fee

\$30 Parking Fee

Miscellaneous costs include:

- \$50 application fee (paid to the College prior to admission to the NA Program)
- \$65 Certification Test Fee (not payable to MC, but payable to take the exam in order to become Certified)
- \$50 lab coat (optional)
- \$60 Methodist College scrubs
- \$40-\$100 clinical equipment
- \$125 books and supplies (*purchased before Orientation, which is held before start of classes*)
- \$40 medical malpractice insurance
- \$28.50 Basic Life Support (CPR) certification to be paid to American Heart Association

Payment Plan Schedule

<i>Payment</i>	<i>Semester Schedule</i>
\$100 Intent Deposit + \$400 Tuition + \$130 in program fees = \$630 Total	Prior to or on First Day
\$500 2 nd Installment	Week 2 of Semester
\$500 Final Installment	Week 7 of Semester

If all fees and tuition are not paid by the final deadline date in the 7th Week of the program, then a Billing Hold will be applied to the account. This will prohibit the student from taking the Nurse's Aide Certification Exam with the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Refund Schedule

Full refund of tuition paid	On or before 8th Day of Semester
75% refund of tuition paid	Day 9 to Day 20 of Semester
50% refund of tuition paid	Day 21 to Day 27 of Semester
Zero refund	Day 28 and after of Semester
