I. POLICY:

No student or individual shall maintain residence in the Methodist College campus except in the residence halls. Only students who have properly applied to live on campus in the residence halls, and paid their room charges, shall be allowed to stay overnight on the campus, unless they are a guest of a resident and stay in the resident's room. No individual or student may establish residency in any part of the college with the exception of residence hall students duly approved to do so. Students who violate the policy will be referred to the Student Conduct Policy for disciplinary action.

II. GENERAL INFORMATION:

For the safety of the individual, and the legal protection of Methodist College, no students can establish residence in the Methodist College building other than those officially approved to do so in the residence halls. Only students approved to live in the residence halls and their approved guests should be in the Methodist College building past midnight. The college official hours are 6:00 AM to midnight seven days a week.
