



Bachelor of Science in Health Science

The Bachelor of Science in Health Science is a degree program that is ideal for students just beginning their journey to healthcare leadership as well as those adult learners who want to assume leadership roles within a healthcare organization. For students who begin their academic careers with us, our curriculum provides learning in Health Sciences, with a concentration in Healthcare Management. Students who have an associate degree in a health-related field can complete their bachelor's degree in Health Sciences by taking approximately 60 credit hours with us, depending on the courses they've previously taken.

Health Science degrees are flexible, and graduates can secure jobs in many fields. The interdisciplinary curriculum offers graduates several career paths in a growing industry. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics projects these occupations to increase by 29% between 2023 and 2033, with over 61,000 openings projected each year on average. Healthcare is an industry where the graduate is able to make a difference in the world around them as they learn the foundation needed to perform in many areas.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 2.0 cumulative college GPA.
- 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) high school GPA.*

* Only required for students with less than 30 college credits.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- Submit all official transcripts.
- Proof of graduation from state-approved high school (diploma or GED certificate). Not required for students who have earned a college degree (associate or higher).

BSHS | Health Sciences

The Bachelor of Science in Health Science is especially attractive to professionals already working in healthcare-related professions such as nutrition, physical therapy, occupational therapy, dental care, radiography and much more. Up to 30 credits earned in an Associate of Applied Science degree related to healthcare or human services will be accepted (credits are evaluated by the Methodist College Registrar). Students just starting out will take curriculum to complete the bachelor's degree with a concentration in Healthcare Management.

Methodist College offers the BSHS program in several formats to meet the needs of adult learners, including online and hybrid options, that could be delivered using video conferences to create a dynamic learning environment that students can experience from their home or office. The BSHS degree program provides a curriculum in areas of general leadership and in healthcare topics such as informatics in healthcare, healthcare management and financial management. The final semester of the program includes an internship at a healthcare or human services organization, that can be designed to fit in a student's work schedule and, in some cases, at the organization where the student works.
