





Bachelor of Science in Nursing -**Accelerated Prelicensure**

Methodist College students can earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree, with accelerated prelicensure, and be prepared to take the national exam to become a registered nurse.

• The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) – Accelerated Prelicensure program is for students who have completed all prerequisite general education courses (45 credits).

The undergraduate curriculum prepares graduates for entrylevel professional practice in a broad range of healthcare settings.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BSN - Accelerated Prelicensure:

- Minimum cumulative college GPA of 3.0/4.0.
- Completion of all prerequisite general education courses. Visit MethodistCol.edu/Accelerated-BSN for a complete listing.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- Apply at MethodistCol.edu/Apply.
- Submit all official college transcripts. High school transcript required for students with less than 30 college credits.
- Proof of graduation from state-approved high school (diploma or GED certificate). Not required for students who have earned a college degree (associate or higher).

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Through classroom lectures, online learning, simulation experiences and extensive clinical experiences in a variety of healthcare settings, graduates of the Methodist College Bachelor of Science in Nursing program are well prepared for careers in nursing.

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Accelerated Prelicensure is a rigorous full-time program for transfer students who've completed all prerequisite general education courses (45 credits). Students enrolled in the Accelerated Prelicensure BSN will complete the program in four semesters, including summers. Please note: This program is ONLY offered as a full-time program.

Upon successful completion of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Accelerated Prelicensure degree, graduates will then be qualified to sit for the national licensing exam, NCLEX-RN. Our first-time pass rate continues to surpass state and national averages.
