



## Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Prelicensure

Methodist College students can earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree and be prepared to take the national exam to become a registered nurse.

- The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) – Prelicensure program is for students directly from high school or transfer students and includes all general education and nursing courses.

The faculty at Methodist College are committed to teaching students to develop critical thinking, clinical decision-making and professional nursing values in an increasingly complex healthcare system. The undergraduate curriculum prepares graduates for entry-level professional practice in a broad range of healthcare settings.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BSN – Prelicensure:

- High school GPA of 2.5/4.0.
- Students who have earned college credit must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5/4.0 or greater.

### ADMISSION PROCESS

- Submit all official college transcripts. High school transcript required for students with less than 30 college credits.
- Proof of graduation from state-approved high school (diploma or GED certificate). Not required for students who have earned a college degree (associate or higher).

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Prelicensure program at Methodist College offers courses to fulfill the general education requirements of a bachelor's degree, but also works with students who bring in eligible credits from other accredited colleges and universities.

Students in the program will be able to attend full time or part time. However, completion of the program is dependent on credit hours completed per semester and/or number of transfer credits applied and the sequencing of clinical courses.
