Many hospitals now require that nurses with an associate degree attain a bachelor's degree in nursing within five years of employment.

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing – RN-BSN program offers a robust curriculum, with the added advantage of allowing students the flexibility to work around busy schedules. Students can also transfer up to 90 of the total 120 credits required to complete the BSN.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Apply at MethodistCol.edu/Apply.
- Submit a copy of valid RN license.
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- 2.0/4.0 cumulative college GPA.
- Valid RN license.
- Completion of a diploma or associate degree from an accredited nursing program.
- Students can transfer up to 90 of the total 120 credits required to complete the BSN.
