Students in the Accelerated Prelicensure Bachelor of Science in Nursing program will maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0. If a student's GPA falls below 3.0 GPA in any semester, students will have one semester to achieve the required cumulative 3.0 GPA. Students may choose to apply to the traditional Prelicensure program if unable to maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Prior to beginning the Accelerated Prelicensure Bachelor of Science in Nursing program, students must have completed all prerequisite general education courses (Students may verify transferability of their completed prerequisite courses, by using the online Transferology™ tool at <https://www.transferology.com/school/mcon>:
