 - Submit OFFICIAL transcripts (or proof of GED) from all high schools attended
 - Students with an earned Associate's Degree (or higher) do not need to submit a high school transcript
 - Students with over 30 earned college credits can submit unofficial high school/GED transcripts
 - Students with less than 30 earned college credits MUST submit official high school/GED transcripts
 - ☐ Submit OFFICIAL transcripts from all colleges attended

- ☐ If you're an applicant with less than 12 college credits earned, you must submit an OFFICIAL copy of your ACT or SAT scores
 - → Many high schools print this on your transcript, but not all. Call your high school to find out!
- After submitting your application, you will be e-mailed a username and password for your CAMS student portal, where you can check the status of your transcripts and admissions decision, obtain a transfer credit report, and view financial aid information.
- Once all official documents are received, an admissions decision will be made in 7-14 business days.
- If more information is needed, the Director of Admissions will contact you by phone and/or e-mail using the contact information specified on your application.

Pathways to Admission

- ✓ **Option 1:** High school cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) AND a minimum ACT score of 17 or minimum SAT score of 900/1600
- ✓ **Option 2:** High school cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) AND 12 or more earned college credits with a 2.0 cumulative GPA
- ✓ Option 3: 30 or more earned college credits with a 2.0 cumulative GPA

Candidates not meeting the above requirements may gain conditional admission:

- ✓ Option 1: High school cumulative grade point average of 2.3-2.49 (on a 4.0 scale) AND a minimum ACT score if 17 or minimum SAT score of 900/1600
- ✓ Option 2: High school cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) AND a minimum ACT score of 16 or minimum SAT score of 890/1600
- ✓ Option 3: High school cumulative grade point average of 2.3-2.49 (on a 4.0 scale) AND 12 or more earned college credits with a 2.0 cumulative GPA
