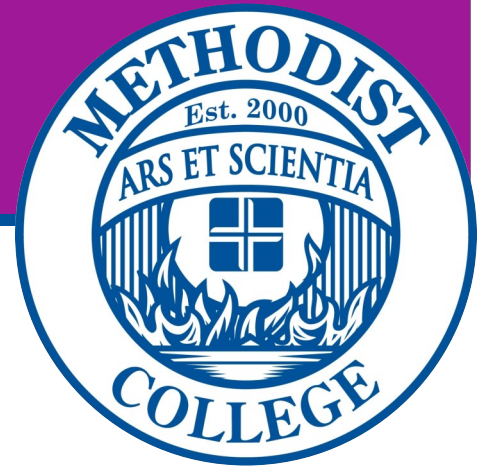


Master of Science in Nursing Pre-Licensure Application Checklist



- Complete the online application for admission (www.methodistCOL.edu/apply)
- Pay the non-refundable \$50 application fee (www.methodistCOL.edu/apply)*
- Submit two recommendation forms (www.methodistCOL.edu/MSNrec)
- Submit a writing sample (maximum 5 double-spaced pages) to admissions@methodistCOL.edu
- Submit OFFICIAL transcripts from all colleges attended

Students who meet the following deadlines will receive priority admission review:

Fall/Summer semesters: April 15
Spring semester: October 15

- **After submitting your application, you will be e-mailed a username and password for your CAMS student portal, where you can check the status of your transcripts and admissions decision, obtain a transfer credit report, and view financial aid information.**
- Once all official documents are received, an admissions decision will be made in 7-14 business days.
- If more information is needed, the Director of Admissions will contact you by phone and/or e-mail using the contact information specified on your application.
- Don't forget to fill out your FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov and have it sent to Methodist College (school code: 006228)

Minimum Admission Requirements

- ✓ Completion of a Baccalaureate Degree from an accredited institution
- ✓ A cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) for all college coursework
- ✓ Completion of all science pre-requisites with a "B" or better [Anatomy & Physiology I (4 credit hours), Anatomy & Physiology II (4 credit hours), & Microbiology (4 credit hours)]

***Applicants not meeting the above GPA requirement who have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA in their baccalaureate studies may request consideration for conditional admission by writing a letter of appeal to the Dean of Nursing.*
