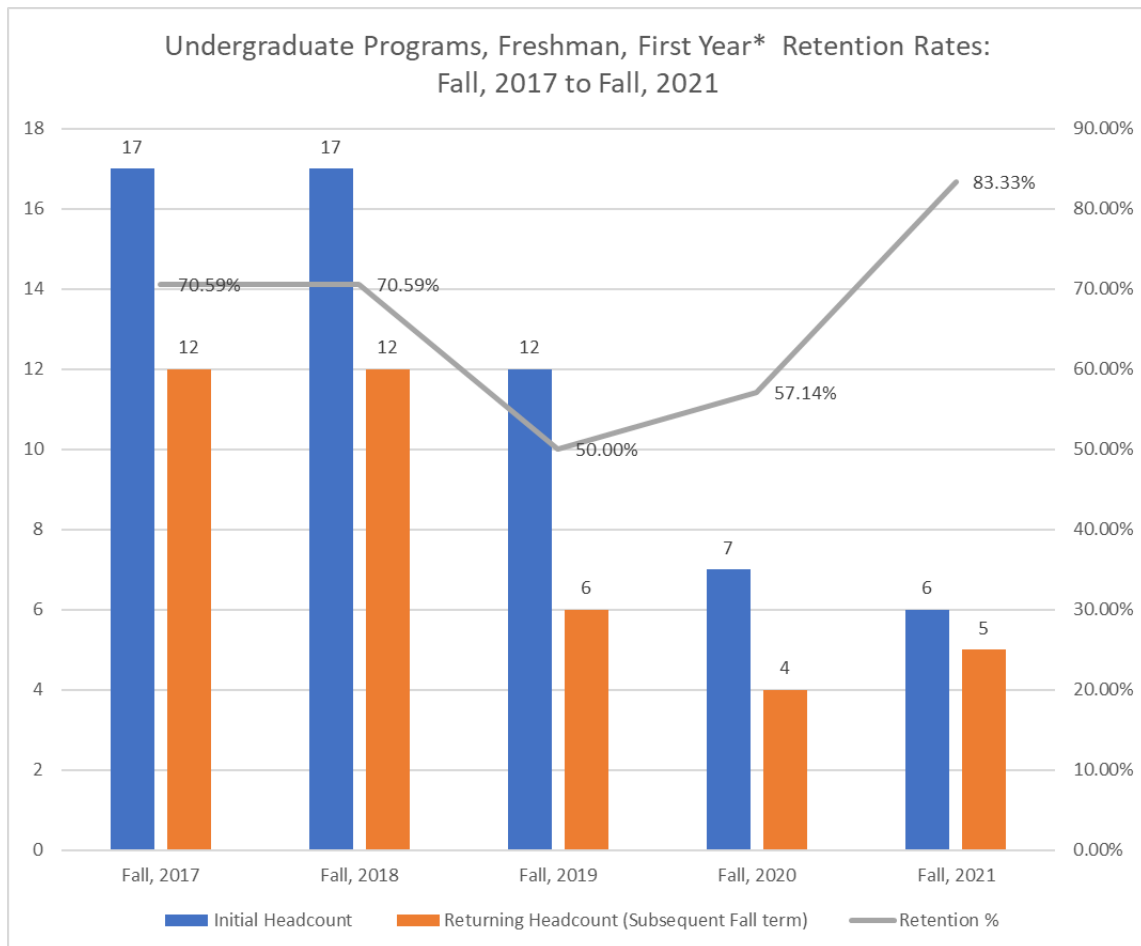

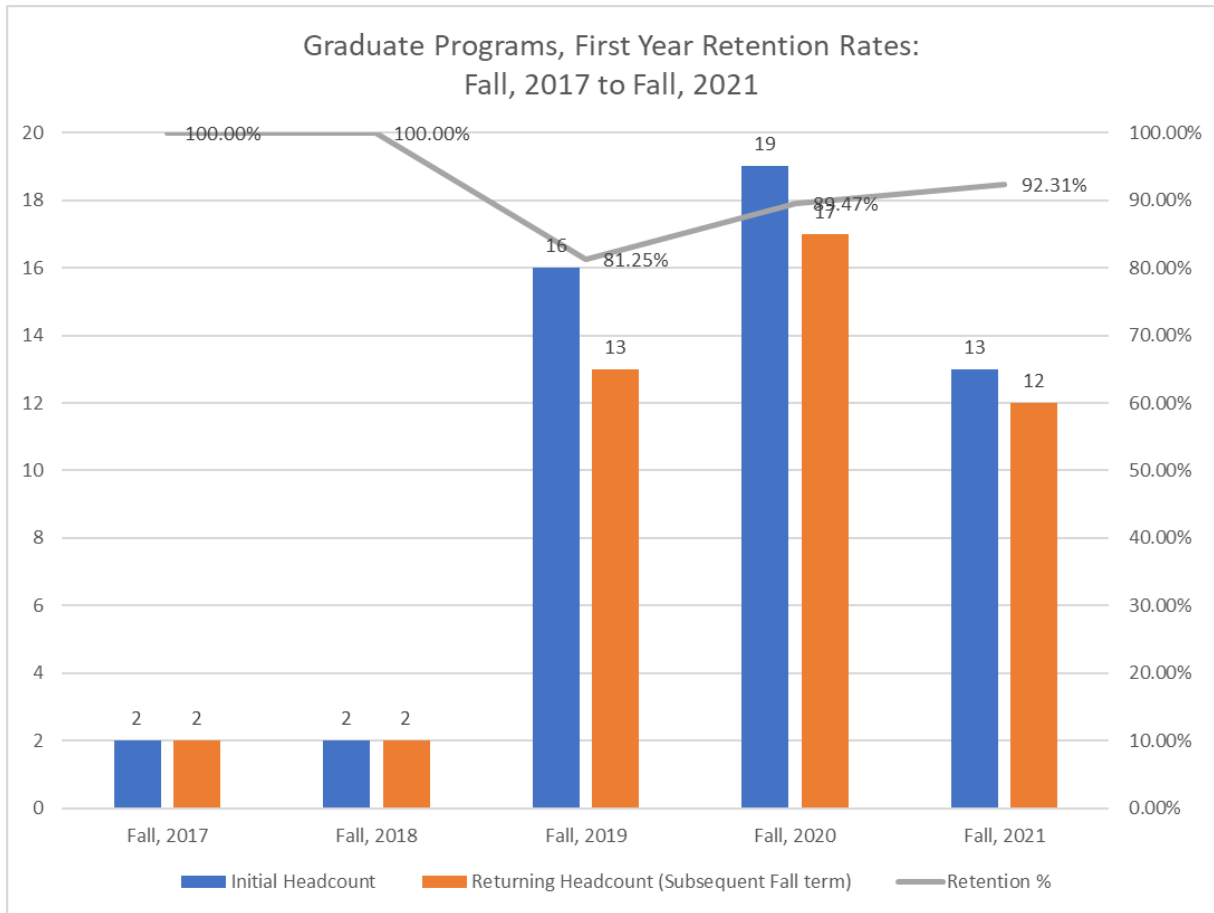

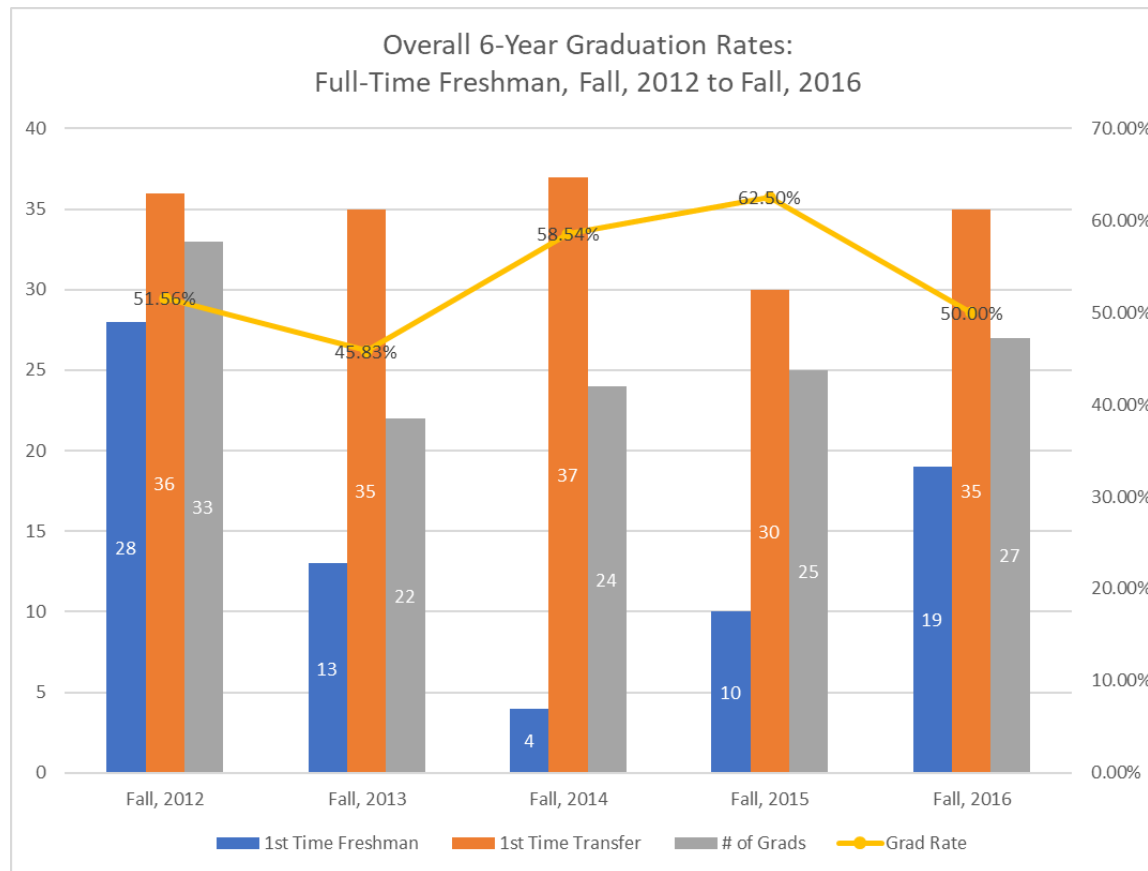
Note: While sharing the same basic definition of “retention” as employed above, the program retention rate adds the qualification that the student needed to return for the same program for which they originally declared in order to be counted as ‘retained’ (e.g. a new start for BS – Healthcare Management would be counted as retained if they returned the following Fall still declared for that program. If the student re-declared for another program, they would not be counted as retained under this definition).
